

:: Summary

This post explains how the word “call” can be used as a noun or a verb. When referring to verbally calling someone, the word “call” can be translated as “chamar” (when used as a verb) or “chamada” (when used as a noun). When specifically referring to using a telephone to call someone, “call” means “telefonar” (when used as verb) or “telefonema” or “ligação” when used as noun.
